ORAL PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

- 1. The official language of the conference is English. All presentations therefore must be conveyed in English. If the use of local dialect is necessary for certain words/phrases, English translations must be provided.
- 2. All presentations must be prepared using PowerPoint. Presentation files should be stored in a flash drive and submitted to the Conference Secretariat upon registration on or before 8:00 AM. The file should be named with the presenter's last name, first name, and paper number (e.g. Dela Cruz_Juan_13)
- 3. A conference laptop, projector, and clicker will be provided during the oral presentation. Presenters will NOT be allowed to use their own laptop computers as this may disrupt the flow of the session. They are allowed, however, to check their presentations on-site.
- 4. If you need other audio-visual equipment (e.g. slide projector, etc.) kindly contact the Secretariat, two weeks before the conference.
- 5. Presenters must report to the session chair 10 min before the start of the session to confirm his/her presence and/or to discuss necessary issues.
- 6. The total allotted time for each presenter is 25 min (15 min for oral presentation and 10 min for questions and answers). During the Q&A, presenters are reminded to keep answers fairly short to allow audience to ask questions.
