POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

Registration

The presenting author of the accepted abstract should register to the conference through the website (www.upvgrc.com) not later than **(21 May 2025)**.

Submission of Posters

The authors of the accepted poster abstracts are required to submit their posters on site to the GRC 2025 Secretariat starting 20 June 2025 at 2:00 PM and remove them on 21 June 2025 after the Closing Program. The poster will be made available for viewing during the day of the conference.

Mechanics

1. The poster must have the following specifications: 48 inches high x 36 inches wide (121.9 x 91.4 cm) in portrait orientation.
2. The poster must include the following:
 - Title
 - Names of author(s) and their affiliations(s); Email of Presenter
 - Abstract (brief summary of objectives, methods, results, and conclusions)
 - Introduction (background, research objectives)
 - Materials and Methods
 - Results (tables, graphs, charts)
 - Conclusions / Recommendations
 - References
 - Acknowledgement
3. The presenting author should stand with their posters during the Poster Session in the morning of the Conference right after the Plenary Talks.
4. Certificates of Appreciation will be given to all poster presenters at the end of the conference.

Additional Guidelines for the Student Poster Presentation Competition

1. GRC 2025 will give Best Poster Presentation Award under Cluster 1 and Cluster 2 to those who delivered outstanding poster presentations.
2. Papers for student competition are included in the Regular Sessions and must follow the guidelines for the submission of the posters.
3. A panel of judges will evaluate the posters and their decision is final.
4. The judging criteria for the poster presentation competition is as follows:

Criteria	%

• Research problem is clearly stated and rationale is well-explained	10
• Objectives/Hypotheses are clearly outlined	10
• Methods are clearly described and appropriate to address research question	10
• Figures/tables are used appropriately; main findings are presented clearly and accurately	10
• Implications of the findings are discussed; conclusions are strongly supported by results and addressed study objectives	10
• Study presents new contribution to science, technology innovation, resource management, or policy formulation	10
Quality of poster appearance and presentation	
• Poster layout has a professional appearance and organization. Images and text arrangement are well done and greatly enhanced understanding.	15
• Presenter interacts well with the listener and shows enthusiasm with the study	10
• Presenter shows mastery of the subject matter and answers questions well	15
